## **2011 Annual Grants Report**

*Released: January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2012*

The Mead Family Foundation is proud to report on its grants from 2011. Grants went primarily to organizations working in K-12 academic education, arts education, strengthening families and crisis prevention. 2011 also marked the first year of the Healthy Eating, Healthy Lifestyles Youth initiative, a program that promotes healthy eating and healthy lifestyles for youth in the Maryland area. Other funding areas include capacity building for emerging non-profits, international relief efforts, and grants to encourage partnership and collaboration in the non-profit community.

Through good economic cycles and bad, the Foundation has supported the leadership and programs of hundreds of area non-profits. This year has been no exception. By the end of 2011, the Foundation extended over \$690,000 dollars in grants to 51 non-profit organizations in Florida, Maryland, North Carolina and Washington D.C.

In 2012, the Mead Family Foundation is committed to continuing its support of empowering youth to have crisis-free lives, strong families, and excellent education.
